## Leaders' Ball, Ritual Competition, Where Will You Be?

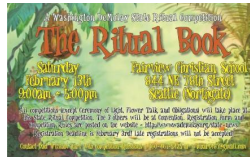

*Registration for the 2016 SRC is past due...*

As we have been announcing since last Convention, we have moved most of the Ritual Competitions from Conclave to our own independent State Ritual Competition. This year it will be held on **Saturday, February 13th at Fairview Christian School in Seattle (Northgate)**. The tournament will run from 8:00am to 5:00pm, with plenty of time to go get changed to attend Leaders' Ball later that evening. Dad William Hart and his Committee are getting things ready for the ritual competitions. Remember that all competitions (except Ceremony of Light, Flower Talk and Obligations) will take place at the State Ritual Tournament. The other three will be at Convention, and Obligations will now become a proficiency examination as well as a 3 Division Competition.

### 2016-2017 State Officer Elections

*Are you interested in running for Elected State Office...*



If you are interested in running for an Elected State Office then you will need to [click here](#) or go the [website](#) (New/Info - State) and checkout details for what you must do in order to be considered and approved to run for office by the Executive Officer. All letters of intent must be **POSTMARKED by February 5, 2016** in order to be considered. You must mail them, or hand deliver, as electronic submissions will not be considered. Please read everything completely as there are a changes to the qualifications to run for office. All details including the following deadlines can be found in the letter from our State Dad Advisor.

1. Friday, **January 1, 2016** - Notice to Chapters requesting Letters of Intent to run for Elected State Office.
2. Friday, **February 5, 2016** - Deadline to submit Letters of Intent to the Executive Officer. Must be Postmarked no later than the deadline date (hand delivered is acceptable, emailed Letters of Intent will NOT be accepted);
3. Saturday, **February 13, 2016** - Candidate Interviews (to be held during the State Ritual Competitions). Time schedule and location to be announced;
4. Sunday, **February 14, 2016**, 12:00pm - "So You Want to be A State Officer Meeting" (discussion with candidates and parents about the responsibilities of being an Elected State Officer and details of the election process and rules). Will be held at the WA DeMolay Offices in Tacoma from Noon to 1:30pm. Mandatory for all candidates.
5. Monday, **February 15, 2016** - Official Announcement of approved candidates and written notice to all candidate applicants.

You have two options - register as a Group (up to 10 attendees at a time) or register as an Individual (have your members register themselves). Either way the Chapters/Groups main contact person will get regular updates on who has registered, what they owe, and what is missing from the registration. Reminder that registration deadline (all the paperwork) must be completed by February 15th. 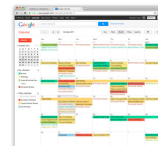
