

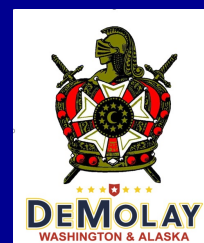

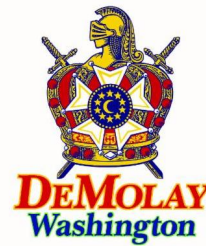

State Officer Elections for the WA State Chapter

Do you want to run for a State Officer position...

The 2018 Washington DeMolay Convention will be held at the Great Wolf Lodge in Ground Mound, Washington from Thursday, April 26 to Sunday, April 29, 2018.



Pursuant to the Washington DeMolay Bylaws and direction of the Executive Officer in Washington, this Notice is given to all DeMolays interested in standing for election to a State Office.

The deadline for submitting a Letter of Intent and supporting documents (**Transcript, Parent Letter, and Advisory Council Letter**) seeking approval to run for any of the following Elected State Officer positions: *State Master Councilor, Deputy State Master Councilor, State Senior Councilor, and State Junior Councilor*, is **POSTMARKED no later than February 10, 2018 (emails will not be accepted)**.

A Letter of Intent is defined as a written letter, stating:

- The full name, age / date of birth, mailing address, email, and phone number (cell and/or home) of the DeMolay Member requesting permission to run for office;
- The name of the DeMolay Chapter in Washington the member is from;
- The Elected State Office for which he is seeking approval to be a candidate;
- A listing of his qualifications to run for the desired office (**[see attached Eligibility Requirements to hold Elected State Office](#)**). Include DeMolay Chapter offices held and the number of members brought into DeMolay as a First-Line Signer;
- Copy of current school official or unofficial transcript. If graduated, a copy of Diploma or Degree equivalent.
- The reason(s) why he is running for Elected State Office and what he hopes to accomplish if elected to State Office (no less than 500 words, but no more than 1000);
- A signed and sealed confidential acknowledgement form signed by the candidate's Chairman and Chapter Dad Advisor. (Form and instructions provided with this Notice); and
- A letter signed by the candidate's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) giving their consent for their son to run for Elected State Office and acknowledgment that they have an understanding of the duties of the position and personal and financial responsibilities of being an Elected State Officer. (Sample provided with this Notice).

All Letters of Intent and supporting documents to run for Elected State Office must be **POSTMARKED no later than February 10, 2018** and must be mailed (hand delivered is acceptable) to:

Executive Officer, Dad Brunson, has set forth the following Approval Process to stand for election:

1. Tuesday, **December 9, 2018** - Notice to Chapters requesting Letters of Intent to run for Elected State Office;
2. Saturday, **February 10, 2018** - Deadline to submit Letters of Intent and supporting documents to the Executive Officer. Must be Postmarked no later than the deadline date (hand delivered is acceptable, emailed Letters of Intent will **NOT** be accepted);
3. Saturday, **February 17, 2018** - Candidate Interviews (to be held prior to Leaders' Ball). Time schedule and location to be announced;
4. Sunday, **February 18, 2018, 12:00pm** - "So You Want to be A State Officer Meeting" (discussion with candidates and parents about the responsibilities of being an Elected State Officer and details of the election process and rules). Will be held at the WA DeMolay Offices in Tacoma from Noon to 1:30pm.
5. Monday, **February 19, 2018** - Official Announcement of approved candidates and written notice to all candidate applicants.

Please note that:

1. Informal campaigning for Elected State Office is not permitted until after official announcement of the approved candidates.
2. Formal campaigning is not permitted until the first day of Convention 2018.

Submission of Proposed State Bylaw Changes

RE: **Request for Bylaw Amendments**

Pursuant the Washington State DeMolay Bylaws, Article XV Section 2, notice to all Chapters and Members of Washington DeMolay is hereby provided that the deadline to submit Amendments to the Washington State DeMolay Bylaws is 60 days prior to the start of Convention.

Accordingly, any submissions for consideration must be submitted in writing to the Washington DeMolay office at 1111 A St, Suite 1919 Tacoma, WA 98402 by **February 18, 2018**. There must be two copies, one for the State Master Councilor and one for the Executive Officer. Electronic submissions may be accepted by the Executive Officer via email to: office@wademolay.org. The current Bylaws may be found on the WA DeMolay website by searching "Bylaws."

In addition to Bylaw Amendments, the Convention body may consider Resolutions which must be submitted no later than **March 18, 2018**.

To ensure a standardized process, we are requesting that any amendments or resolutions be submitted in substantially the following manner:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED BY: Russell Wilson, Seahawks Chapter

SUMMARY: To Change the Bylaws to make every Bylaw Article XII.

PROPOSED: That the Washington DeMolay Bylaws be amended to change the Article Numbers from their current ascending Roman Numeral value to Article XII.

RATIONALE: To show our Seahawk "12" Pride, each Article should be renumbered to XII. The boost in moral as a result of this change is expected to outweigh the slight, if not negligible, inconvenience of not being able to navigate the Bylaws by referring to a unique Article Number.

PROPOSED EFFECTIVE DATE: December 12, 2018

Annual Nominations for Honors

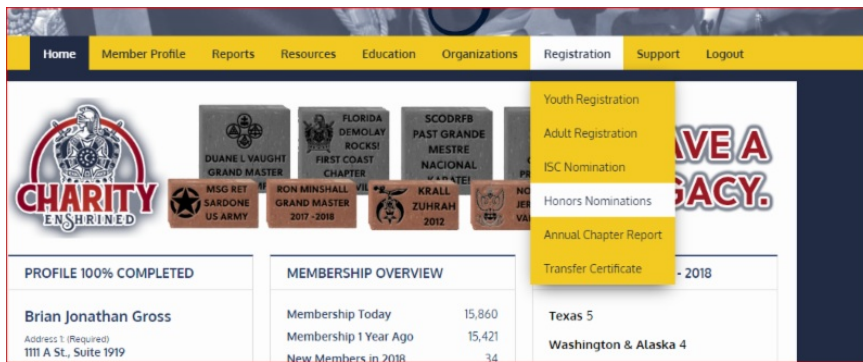
Do you have anyone who should be nominated...



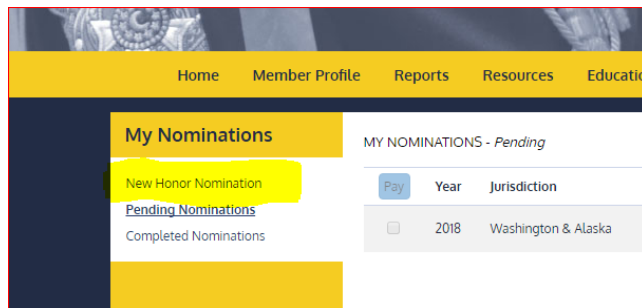
Once again it is time for each Chapter to review it's membership and determine if anyone should be nominated for one of DeMolay's honors. You can nominate appropriate individuals for the **Chevalier Degree**, the **Cross of Honor**, or the **Legion of Honor** (both active and honorary). Your Council should discuss the eligible individuals and then if you have anyone to nominate follow the process. You should read the download from Dad Brunson available by [clicking here](#), about each honor and what you should be considering when making a nomination. The deadline to submit nominations is March 1st and this is a hard deadline. Nominations will not be accepted after that date. You will need to login to eScribe in order to make your nomination.

This process will be managed in eScribe, Simply click on "Honor Nominations" located under

registrations as shown below.



Once you do that you should click on "New Honor Nomination" and the form will open for you to fill out all the necessary information to make your nomination. Have the member ID# of the person you are nominating to make things easier when filling in their profile. If you need to come back to the form later you can save without submitting and come back to it later. Once complete simply submit and you will be asked for payment and your nomination will be sent to the Executive Officer for his approval. 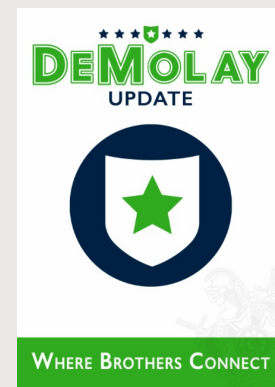

\$1,000 - Masonic Youth Group - (three)

Who Can Apply - All High School Seniors who are residents of Washington State and who plan to attend a 4-year University, 2-year Community College or 2-year Vocational Technical School may apply for the Senior and Vocational/Technical Scholarships. The Masonic Legacy Scholarship is

How to Apply - Our application is online at www.washboard.org. All you need to do is sign-up for an account, complete the application, and upload a few items like transcripts, letters of recommendation, and work history. We ask for FAFSA information. Chairmen - Annual Reports Are Now Available in eScribe

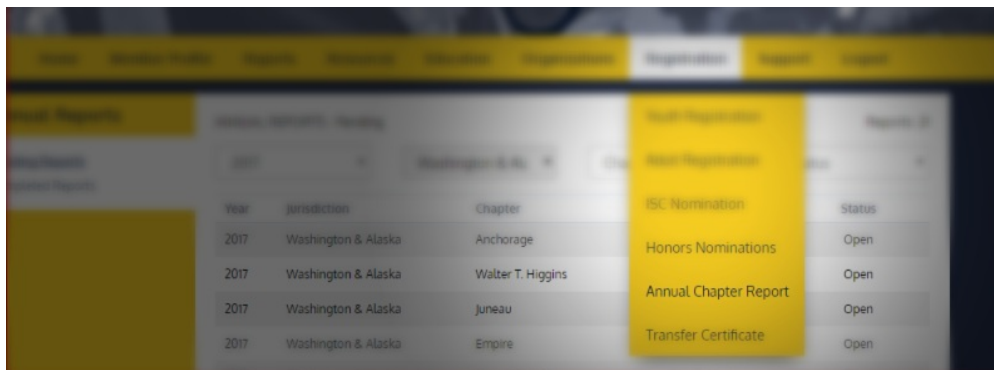
Annual reports are due by Feb. 28th this year...



Chairmen, as most of you know each year we have to fill out the Chapter's annual report. This includes most of your Chapter's vital details and keeps DeMolay International properly informed so that they can communicate with you and send mail and awards among other things to you.

Login to eScribe and click on "Annual Chapter Report" under the registration tab as shown below. On the next screen you should see your Chapter listed. Click on the "view/edit report" highlight and it will open the report for you to begin.

You will need to have your chapter's financial information for the year in addition to any information about the activities of the Chapter during the past year. You will be able to save your progress and come back to the report if you need to before submitting. **Please be sure to check that you see all Advisors and new members from the past year reflected in the report.** This will take a little longer than many of the other processes in eScribe, so please start early to give yourself enough time to complete it properly. 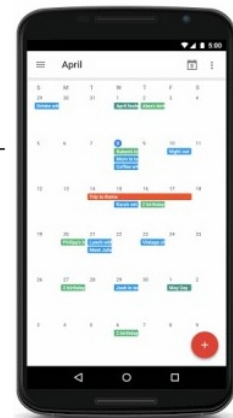
